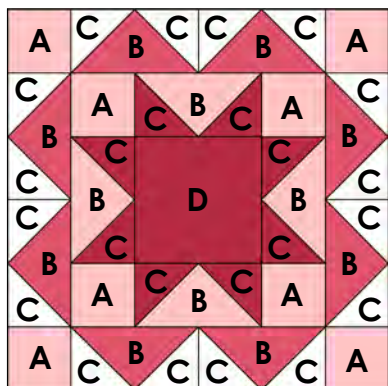


## Cutting



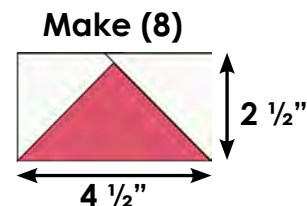
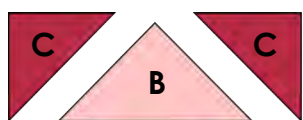
**PLEASE NOTE:** Flying Geese Units in the Block #5 Pattern are shown in two colorways. You may opt to create only one colorway of flying geese unit, or two. Plan your fabric placement before cutting, then cut according to the quantity of fabrics you wish to use.

<b>A</b>	(8) 2 1/2" squares. <i>Grunge #30150 64</i>
<b>B</b>	(3) 5 1/4" squares; cut each square twice diagonally to make (12) B triangles. <i>Grunge 1-101 &amp; 2-332</i>
<b>C</b>	(12) 2 7/8" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (24) C triangles. <i>Grunge cut 8-101 &amp; 4-332</i>
<b>D</b>	Cut (1) 4 1/2" square. <i>Grunge #30150 332</i>

## Assembly

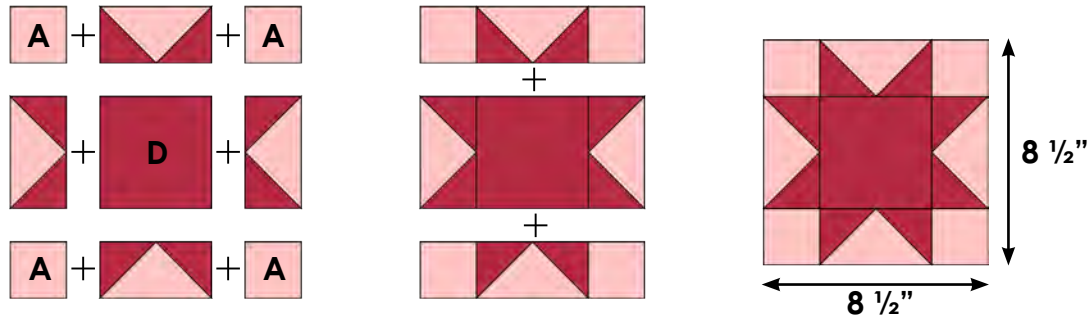
**PLEASE NOTE:** Flying geese units are shown in two colorways. Both colorways are the same size. Use the following instructions to make flying geese units in two colorways.

- Organize and separate B triangles and C triangles by flying geese colorway. Create (8) units for one colorway, and (4) units for colorway two. Choose (1) colorway to begin piecing first.
- Begin flying geese unit assembly by placing (1) C triangle on either side of (1) B triangle.
- Sew the C triangles to the B triangles one at a time using a scant 1/4" seam. Press toward the corners.
- Trim flying geese units to measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.
- Repeat to make (8) identical flying geese units in one colorway, and (4) identical flying geese units in colorway two. All units should measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.

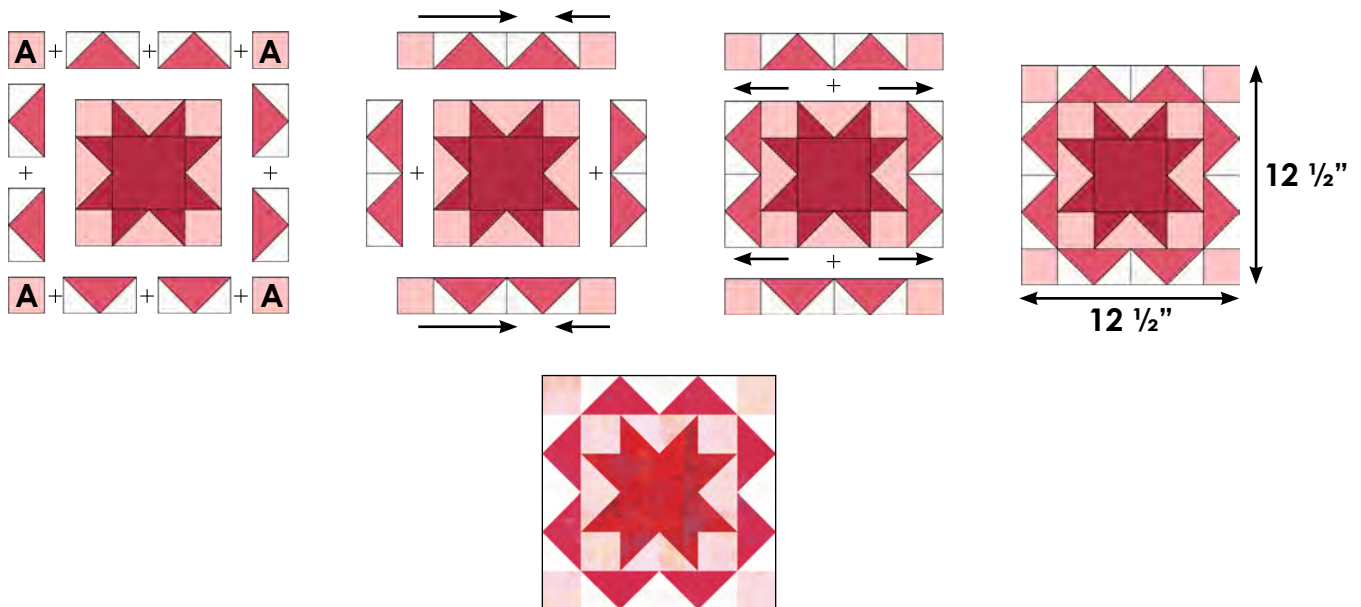


- Begin making the block star center using (4) identical flying geese units, (4) A squares and (1) D square. Lay out as shown.

7. Sew together in horizontal rows pressing all seams away from the flying geese units.
8. Sew horizontal rows together to complete the block star center. Trim the block star center to measure  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



9. Continue block assembly by placing (4) A squares and (8) identical flying geese units around the block star center as shown. Please note the orientation of the outermost flying geese units.
10. Sew together in (3) horizontal rows. Arrows indicate pressing instructions.
11. Sew horizontal rows together to complete the block.
12. Press away from the block center star to complete. Completed block should measure  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
